- Vin de Pays**
130. **Cabernet Franc** - Domaine Mas Barrau 20.50
A wine of real character, there is a wild ripeness of sweet scented fruit twinned with an edgy woodland perfume. An incredibly long and very rich palate.
131. **Merlot** - Domaine de Bahourat 20.50
Incredibly well balanced and easy to drink, engorged with sumptuous red fruit, rippling with nuances of crushed morello cherries and crunchy fragrant minty dark chocolate. Seriously good without being too serious!
132. **Pinot Noir, Domaine de Valmoissine** - Louis Latour 29.95
A pale mahogany wine with bold, lively fruit aromas. Medium acidity, supple tannins and round structure, combine deliciously with floral notes to create a suave, fine wine.
Tom Stevenson from the Sotheby's Wine Encyclopedia has described this wine as,
'...easily the greatest vin de pays Pinot Noir ever produced.'

133. **Vallet Frères, Beaune Premier Cru Les Epenottes, 2005** 68.00
Classic Pinot fruit with supple tannins, crisp acidity and delicious red berries on the palate - drink now or keep for 5-8 years to see exactly what these wines can achieve with age.
134. **Nuit-St-Georges, 1999** - Louis Latour 69.00
Ripe Cassis and black cherry fruit aromas, vegetable mushroomy character with a long elegant finish, showing a rich vanilla flavour. A classic!
- Rhône**
135. **Côtes du Rhône** - La Chapelle du Marin 21.50
Rich raspberry and cherry fruit flavours giving way to a hint of spice. Soft and smooth on the palate with balanced structure and supple tannins.
- Italy**
136. **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** - Conviviale 19.75
This generously flavoured red captures the warmth of southern Italy. Selected Montepulciano grapes give rich and cherry fruit characters with spice and complexity.
137. **Ca' di Ponti Nero d'Avola** 18.50
A deeply coloured, medium-bodied, spicy red with aromas of ripe plum and black cherry. The palate combines warm, juicy red fruit flavours with savoury, lightly smoky characters, a hint of bitter chocolate and nip of tannin on the finish.

138. **Barbera d'Asti 'Ceppi Storici', 2008** - Araldica 25.00
An attractive vibrant damson, curranty character dominates, whilst a subtle, smoky flavour adds interest and soft, oak tannins offer an extra dimension to the texture. A refreshing smack of juicy acidity gives plenty of definition to the ripe fruit.

139. **Campos de Viento Old Vine Tempranillo** - Estate Wine 19.95
100% Tempranillo - this wine aims to be a pure expression of the Tempranillo grape variety. As there is no possibility to blend with any other variety, complexity is achieved by blending different types of Tempranillo.

140. **Rioja, Tempranillo** - Bodegas Artesa 22.00
Ripe plum and cherry fruit characters are balanced by good acidity and a nip of tannin giving a lovely wine that is soft and easy drinking.
141. **Rioja Reserva, 2007** - Vega Del Rayo 29.95
Rich flavoured and spicy, this classic Rioja combines ripe plum and dried fruit characters with cinnamon and vanilla.
- Argentina**
142. **Malbec Reserva** - Nieto Senetiner 25.95
A powerful red with great concentration of berry fruit. Complex flavours of plums, figs and dried fruit with a smoky vanilla character.
- Australia**
143. **Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot** - Outrider 19.95
Appealing, up-front aromas of fresh, ripe berry fruit mingle with light spice and minty eucalyptus flavours in the mouth. Smooth and full on the palate with a nicely balanced structure, sweet, ripe fruit on the finish and a hint of spice.

144. **The Big Top Red Zinfandel** 23.95
Round and full with excellent poise this Zinfandel is beautifully balanced and positively bulging with unforgettable fruit flavours.

- Chile**
145. **Merlot** - Oyster Catcher 18.95
An elegant and lively aroma of cedar and plums with a hint of mint that progresses into the glass with a delicate balance of spicy berry fruit and a twist of pepper. This is a full bodied ripe Merlot red wine.

146. **Adobe Carmenère** 24.50
Its aroma reflects ripen fruit perfectly balanced with sweet and toasted notes given by wood and a touch of spices. In palate, this wine has soft and well balanced volume with ripen tannins that leaves a great flavour and persistence.

Cousino Macul
This elegant Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in French Oak for 12 months and rested in the bottle for a further 6 months prior to its release. It shows hints of spices, cherries and blackcurrant. A stunning wine!

148. **Cabernet Sauvignon** - Cape Heights 18.95
Rich in fruit flavours with cherry stone aromas leading to a palate laden with cassis and a warming wood spice finish.

151. **Côtes du Rhône Rosé** - Les Cerisiers 23.50
A pale, sublime and very elegant rosé with a lovely soft plump texture and good depth and length; delicate fresh red fruit flavours combined with the aromatic herbal perfumes of the Southern Rhône. Perfect!

	Ultra clean, appealing textbook Viognier aromas of ripe pears and peaches with a twist of Turkish delight merge into a palate of matching flavours.

102.	Alsace Pinot Gris, Cave Tradition - Turckheim	27.95
	The 'Cave Tradition' wines represent their standard quality range of classic Alsace varietals. The Pinot Gris has a lovely perfumed nose with fine floral aromas mixed with a tad of honey and spice; quite full and rich, lightly smoky and nutty with smooth dryish finish.	
103.	Burgundy Chablis - La Colombe	31.95
	Not a trace of oak, pungent and flinty on the nose, with a tad of creamy fruit underneath, this gets richer as the mineral characters give way to riper buttery sensations, but then cut back by a long crisp bite.	
104.	Chablis Premier Cru Montmains - Maison Pascal Bouchard	56.00
	Unoaked, fruity dry white. Deep, flinty with mineral notes, slightly citrus perfume. Well-proportioned with crisp acidity and a lingering flavour.	
105.	Vallet Frères, Meursault, 2008	69.00
	The Meursault has rich green-gold colour and heady, lightly oaky but seductive nutty bouquet; the palate is pretty fat and buttery but cut with toasty hazelnut flavours and long mineral balance.	
106.	Languedoc Duc de Morny Picpoul de Pinet, Coteaux du Languedoc	25.50
	Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh on the palate with pear drop fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. Nicknamed 'la bomba' this is incredibly fruity and concentrated Picpoul - yet still fine and elegant, with a very long finish.	
107.	Loire Muscadet Sur Lie - Les Grands Presbytères	23.50
	Sourced from St Fiacre - one of the best sites for Muscadet, the wine has delicate pear and apple fruit on the palate with crisp acidity.	
108.	Sancerre - La Clochette	33.00
	Deep, crisp and elegant with fresh gooseberry fruit dominating the senses. The palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with the right balance of texture and refreshing acidity.	
109.	Germany Piesporter Michelsberg - Schmitt Söhne	18.50
	A fragrant medium dry wine with up front fruit. Hints of peaches and green apples that are balanced perfectly with crisp acidity to give a clean, fresh finish.

113.	Gavi 'Conchetta' - La Battistina	22.95
	A gently aromatic, dry white with green apple, lime and herbaceous characters, typical of the local Cortese grape. Lightly herbal and savoury notes combine with the fruit flavours to give a textured palate.

114.	Spain Rioja Viura - Artesa	21.50
	100% unoaked Viura. Clean, fresh and attractive nose showing hints of ripe peach and pear. Ripe, round and almost creamy palate cut through with a refreshing streak of zesty acidity.	
115.	Argentina Nieto Reserve Torrontes	25.95
	Delicate flower blossom combines perfectly with herbaceous, white peach and orange peel notes. Well balanced, weighty palate - floral but poised and very drinkable!	

116.	Australia Chardonnay - The Last Stand	22.50
	An elegant, easy drinking white. This vibrant, peachy Chardonnay exhibits all the rich mouth-feel, weight and generosity of fruit expected whilst retaining acidity and offering more elegant melon and citrus characters.	
117.	Chile Sauvignon Blanc - Oyster Catcher	18.95
	A delicate aroma of fresh peaches with a twist of gooseberry rises from the glass to deliver fruity crisp and refreshing dry white wine with citrus hints.

	Counted among the best in champagne. The style is versatile, suited to most 'Champagne occasions'.

	Yellow gold. Understated hazelnut nose with some good yeast complexity. Impressive concentration with a sweet berry structure overlaid with a biscuity character.	
127.	Champagne, Sir Winston Churchill, 1998 - Pol Roger	165.00
	Sir Winston Churchill's favourite Champagne. In his words - "My tastes are simple. I am easily satisfied with the best."

128.	Italy Moscato Passito, 37.5cl - Araldica	19.95
	Made from the native Moscato grape and dried on 'graticci' - a traditional Italian rush mat. Fermented and aged in oak for 12 months. This wine has a deep golden colour and an intensely aromatic flavour with apricot and acacia honey notes.

	With aromas of roses and a berry like taste, rich and full flavoured and perfect to accompany a variety of desserts which might overpower other wines.
